My name is Dale Fulfs and I'm the Fire Chief of North County Regional Fire Authority which is the Fire District that covers the area of Logen Rd. / 292nd St NW road closure as proposed under Docket TR-090121. As Fire Chief I have some concerns regarding the closure of Logen Road as it will limit the routes used to response to the area of Old Pacific Highway. If the Logen Road is closed it could possibly affect response times to the Old Pacific Highway area and with increased response time's public safety could be put at risk. Logen Road is not a well traveled road so I believe Logen Road could easily remain open even with the siding put in place with an update to crossing arms. Please reconsider the closing of Logen Road as I believe public safety could be affected by longer response times and limited access to the Old Pacific Highway area.

I received a phone call from Lynn Logen on Tuesday regarding some testimony from

Gary Norris from DN Traffic Consultant at the recent public hearing regarding the Logen Road closure. To clear up what Lynn Logen told me is that Gary Norris stated that this area is covered by Stanwood City Fire Department and the response time would be twelve minutes. North County Regional Fire Authority covers the Logen Road closures area and the response times would be approximately six to eight minutes . Again in the interest of public safety please keep the Logen Road open for emergency responses . If you need any further clarifications please let me know .
