	PacifiCorp seeks clarification that proposed WAC 480-108-040(7)(a) applies "only to those facilities that meet the definition of a 'net metering system' under chapter 80.60 RCW."
	PacifiCorp seeks clarification that the requirements to evaluate the cumulative effects of interconnections specified in proposed WACs 480-108-065 and 480-108-120 may be met by "analysis of all customer-based generation of 20 MW or less as a part of PacifiCorp's distribution planning study program."
Public Counsel	Public Counsel supports adoption of the rule amendments as proposed.
	Public Counsel notes that the proposed rule ensures that interconnection charges are cost-based and are charged based on causation. The dispute resolution process is available to interconnection customers to dispute cost assignment if other customers are shown to benefit from an interconnection. According to Public Counsel, "strike a fair division of costs between the interconnection customer and other ratepayers."
ICNU	ICNU supports adoption of the rule amendments as proposed.
