NOTICE OF POTENTIAL EX PARTE COMMUNICATION (Rebuttal statements due April 22, 2022)

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Puget Sound Energy, Dockets UE-220066 and UG-220067 (Consolidated)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 31, 2022, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-60, Tariff G, Electric Service, and its currently effective Tariff WN U-2, Natural Gas. The Company characterizes this filing as a general rate case (GRC).

Earlier, on November 24, 2021, PSE filed a Petition for an Order Authorizing Deferred Accounting Treatment (Petition) in Docket UG-210918. PSE requested deferred accounting treatment for the Company's share of costs associated with the Tacoma Liquified Natural Gas facility.

On April 11, 2022, the presiding administrative law judge and the Director of the Administrative Law Division for the Commission received an email from Commission staff (Staff) asking whether the Petition would be consolidated with the pending GRC. This email included earlier responses from other Staff members who referred to the substance of their testimony in the GRC. Pursuant to WAC 480-07-310(4), this email is attached to this Notice along with the response from the Director of the Administrative Law Division.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That pursuant to WAC 480-07-310(4), any party in this docket may file a written rebuttal statement concerning the matters raised by Staff's email on April 11, 2022. Any such statement must be filed by April 22, 2022.
