At the February 6, 2003 prehearing conference, the Administrative Law Judges directed any interested parties to submit proposals regarding time and motion studies to Qwest by February 14. The ALJs also directed Qwest to respond in writing to such proposals by February 21. The ALJs indicated their intention to issue a prehearing conference order which, among other things, would define the Commission's view of the appropriate scope of time and motion studies (ordering only, ordering and provisioning, etc.) by February 14. Finally, the ALJs indicated that any party requiring additional time could request such an extension.
