NOTICE OF VIRTUAL EVIDENTIARY HEARING (Set for Tuesday, March 14, 2023, at 9:30 a.m.)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 15, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) served on Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) the formal complaint (Complaint) of Alexander and Elena Argunov, Thomas and Heidi Johnson, and Chad and Victoria Groesbeck (Complainants). The Complaint alleges that PSE violated several Commission rules contained in Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-100.

On November 1, 2022, the Commission entered Order 01, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Order 01), which established a procedural schedule that included, among other things, an evidentiary hearing set for March 14, 2023, at 9:30 a.m. In Order 01, the Commission stated that it would determine at a later date whether the hearing would be conducted in-person or virtually.
