On September 30, 2021, Avista filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) tariff sheets to revise its Tariffs WN U-28 (electric) and WN U-29 (gas), which governs Avista's provision of electric and natural gas service in Washington.

On December 12, 2022, the Commission entered Orders 10/04, Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Granting Petition; Approving and Adopting Full Multiparty Settlement Stipulation Subject to Conditions; and Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing in the above-referenced dockets.
