Verizon Northwest Inc. ("Verizon NW") submits for filing Advice No. 3201 containing the attached tariff sheets to become part of the General and Local Exchange Tariff, WN U-17. An original and nine (9) copies are being provided pursuant to Paragraph 14 of Order No. 01 in Docket No. UT-050814 dated June 23, 2005.

The company submits this Advice filing in compliance with Condition No. 2 in the Commission's Order No. 7 in the above referenced docket dated December 23, 2005.

In Advice No. 3187 dated February 17, 2006, Verizon NW eliminated the Service Adder charge for Premium Plus Flat and Premium Plus Measured Optional Local Calling Plans for both residential and business customers in Fairfield, Farmington, Latah, Oakesdale, Rockford, Rosalia and Tekoa. Verizon NW stated in Advice No. 3187 that it would file for the entire Premium Plus calling area to become a local calling area no later than September 1, 2006 in compliance with Order No. 7. Advice No. 3187 became effective on March 1, 2006.

With this Advice Filing, Verizon NW will eliminate the Premium Plus Flat and Premium Plus Measured Optional Local Calling Plans for both residential and business customers from the General and Local Exchange Tariff, WN U-17. In addition, Verizon NW will expand the local calling areas for the following exchanges.


