TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On March 20, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed with the Code Reviser a Preproposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101) to consider possible additions or modifications to certain sections in Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-07, the Commission's procedural rules.

The Commission received written comments on its CR-101 on May 21, 2013, and its draft rules for Part I of this chapter, WAC 480-07-010 through 180, on December 20, 2013. As a result of the written comments, Commission staff has developed revised draft rules for review and comment by interested persons.
