## **REQUEST:**

Please provide the policy relied upon and implemented by Avista in its Pullman pilot project with regard to "opt-out" of meter installation. In your response, provide customer education materials and internal corporate instructions to its employees as to what the policy was and how it was to be implemented for this pilot program.

## **RESPONSE:**

The Company did not adopt a meter opt-out policy for the advanced metering deployment in its Pullman pilot project. Several customers did express concern about the installation of advanced meters, but in each case, Avista employees effectively responded to their issues and concerns. Consequently, there were no customers who opposed the installation of an advanced meter during the deployment.
