On Wednesday, April 17, 2019, the Proposed Transactions in the above-captioned docket closed. In accordance with Commitments 64 and 65 of the Commitments agreed to in that docket, on April 18, Puget Holdings and each of the owners of Puget Holdings filed declarations attesting to the requirements of Commitments 64 and 65. The one-day delay in filing these declarations was a technical violation of Commitments 64 and 65, which required the filing of such documents *prior* to closing. Accordingly, in accordance with Commitment 64, Puget Sound Energy, through this letter, is reporting this technical violation to the Commission. To prevent a future delay, Puget Holdings has implemented a schedule and notification process to ensure that all such future deadlines are adhered to. In accordance with Commitment 64, this compliance report will be served on Commission Staff and Public Counsel.
