NOTICE OF HEARING

RE: *Sarah Hand v. Rainier Water View Company, Inc.*,

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 8, 2016, Sarah Hand (Complainant) contacted the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to raise issues about the quality of the water she is receiving from Rainier View Water Company, Inc. (Rainier View or Company). On August 31, 2017, the Commission converted Ms. Hand's complaint into a formal complaint (Complaint), and initiated this adjudicative proceeding.

On December 18, 2017, the Commission convened a prehearing conference, and on January 9, issued a notice of procedural schedule including an evidentiary hearing on July 25, 2018.

On June 14, 2018, Rainier View filed a Motion to Compel Discovery, which alleged that the Complainant failed to respond to the Company's document requests issued on April 2, 2018. Responses to the Motion are due on Thursday, June 21, 2018.

On June 15, 2018, the Commission issued a notice setting Rainier View's Motion to Compel Discovery for hearing on June 25, 2018.

On June 18, 2018, Sarah Hand filed a Motion to Compel WUTC to Designate Speaking Agent(s) to Testify at Deposition and a Motion to Compel Rainier View to Produce Documents (collectively Complainant's Motions). The Commission finds good cause to shorten the time for responses to these motions to enable the Commission to consider all pending discovery motions at the previously scheduled hearing on June 25, 2017.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That responses to the Complainant's Motions are due by 5 p.m. on Thursday, June 21, 2018.

THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE That the Commission will hear arguments on the Complainant's Motions, as well as Rainier View's motion, at the previously-scheduled hearing, beginning at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, June 25, 2018, in the Commission's hearing room, Room 206, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Dr. SW, Olympia, Washington.
