Re: Docket UE-190666—PacifiCorp's Standard Power Purchase Agreement Revision to Proposed Effective Date

On May 28, 2020, PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp) submitted a standard power purchase agreement (Standard PPA) as an attachment to Schedule QF, Avoided Cost Purchases and Procedures for Qualifying Facilities, in compliance with WAC 480-106 et. seq.

PacifiCorp continues to be engaged in discussions with the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers and the Renewable Energy Coalition regarding the Standard PPA, and needs additional time to continue negotiations. In addition, to reflect guidance received from Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission Staff, PacifiCorp is planning to submit two versions of the Standard PPA—one for new contracts, and a separate one for renewed contracts. PacifiCorp requests to extend the effective date to January 31, 2021.
