Dear Judge Clark:

After discussion among the parties, we wish to make the following proposal as a way to efficiently resolve this docket. Each party has authorized me to communicate this proposal to you:

- The parties agree to waive hearing in the current REC phase of this docket
- The parties will have an opportunity to file a reply brief
- The Commission should strike the two sentences in Exhibit No. ___ (ALK-2CT) (rebuttal testimony of PacifiCorp witness Ms. Andrea Kelly, on page 6, line 20, to page 7, line 2 (text beginning "As I stated ..." and ending "... of the stipulation.")

If the UTC decides to have a hearing, the foregoing does not apply, and the parties have all the rights they had before, and the existing procedural schedule would remain in effect. In either event (hearing or no hearing), the parties will file cross exhibits, if any, pursuant to this Thursday's deadline.

Please let us know at your earliest convenience whether this proposal is acceptable to the Commission.
