This rulemaking would consider possible corrections and changes to rules in Chapter 480-120 WAC, Telephone Companies, and Chapter 480-80 WAC, Utilities General—Tariffs, Price Lists, and Contracts, relating to telecommunications.

(a) Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject:

RCW 80.01.040 and RCW 80.04.160,

- (b) Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: The Commission completed a comprehensive review of its rules in Chapter 480-120, Telephone Companies in 2002. The rules in Chapter 480-80 WAC took effect in June 2002. The rules in Chapter 480-120 took effect in July 2003. While implementing these rules, stakeholders and agency staff have identified a variety of issues with the rules, including unclear provisions, incomplete cross-references, inconsistencies with federal law, and provisions that have been struck down in court. In addition, there are provisions from the prior rules that were not an issue during the comprehensive review that have since become an issue. This rulemaking would consider possible corrections, changes, and clarifications to address the above issues and others that may emerge during the rulemaking process.
