PacifiCorp DRAFT 2009 Request for Proposals**

Dear Ms Washburn:

In a letter dated September 2, 2005 filed in the above docket, PacifiCorp, doing business as Pacific Power & Light ("PacifiCorp" or the "Company"), requested that the Commission extend the time for Commission consideration and decision on PacifiCorp's 2009 Request for Proposals for a Flexible Resource ("RFP 2009") by approximately thirty (30) days. For the same reasons as set forth in that letter, PacifiCorp requests that the time extension be increased from thirty (30) days to sixty (60) days.

As noted in the September 2 letter, PacifiCorp is currently undertaking a review and update of its resource assumptions as part of its routine process for updating its Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP"). Although PacifiCorp expects to complete that update and file the results during October 2005, PacifiCorp has determined that additional time will likely be necessary to determine the impact, if any, on the amount and/or timing of the 2009 need and communicate with all parties. PacifiCorp submits that it would be in the public interest to extend the date for Commission action on the draft RFP 2009 by approximately sixty (60) days, or until November 30, 2005.
