1 On October 25, 2005, Katherine A. Long-Felsch, d/b/a Quality Care Unlimited, filed application GA-79409, under the provisions of RCW 81.77 and WAC 480-70 for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate motor vehicles in solid waste collection service consisting of:

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE limited to bags and cans in that portion of Stevens County described as:

Highway 25 from the community of Rice (the intersection of Highway 25 and Orin Rice road) to the Spokane River.

The Orin-Rice Road for a distance of 5 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Daisy Mine Road for a distance of 5 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Addy-Gifford Road for a distance of 5 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Cedonia-Addy Road for a distance of 8 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Springdale-Hunters Road for a distance of 8 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Fruitland Valley Road for a distance of 10 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

2 The application appeared on the November 28, 2005, application docket and was unopposed.

3 Upon consideration of all the evidence of record, the commission finds that the applicant is fit, willing and able to properly conduct the proposed operations and it appears that the service sought to be rendered is necessary and will be a convenience to the public.

ORDER

4 IT IS ORDERED That application GA-79409, of Katherine Long-Felsch, d/b/a Quality Care Unlimited is granted conditioned upon compliance with the laws and rules governing solid waste collection service, and that a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be issued as per the attached Appendix A.

5 The commission further orders that the tariff filed in connection with this application will become effective at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the service date of this order.

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE limited to bags and cans in that portion of Stevens County described as:

Highway 25 from the community of Rice (the intersection of Highway 25 and Orin Rice road) to the Spokane River.

The Orin-Rice Road for a distance of 5 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Daisy Mine Road for a distance of 5 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Addy-Gifford Road for a distance of 5 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Cedonia-Addy Road for a distance of 8 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Springdale-Hunters Road for a distance of 8 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.

The Fruitland Valley Road for a distance of 10 miles from its intersection with Highway 25.
