

3. Ensure that drivers provide a 10-year employment history on their employment application.
4. Ensure that all drivers are fully and properly qualified before operating in interstate commerce. Maintain a complete file as required for each driver, documenting the qualification process.
5. Ensure that all documents supporting records of duty status (such as toll, fuel repair and other on-the-road expense receipts, as well as invoices, bills of lading, dispatch records, etc.) are kept on file for at least 6 months.
6. If you want some drivers to use the 100 air-mile radius exemption, make sure that the drivers meet all terms of the exemption, including being released from duty no more than 12 hours from when they report for duty. Logs must be prepared if a driver does not meet the 12 hour requirement.
7. Keep all driver vehicle inspection reports, signed, certified, and reviewed as required on file for at least 90 days.
8. Periodically review the maintenance and inspection records for all lease vehicles as required by Part 396 of the FMCSR. Keep a record to document these reviews and notify the vehicle owner of any violations detected.
9. Review with your drivers periodically the procedures for doing pre-trip and post-trip inspections. Ensure that safety defects reported by drivers on their Vehicle Inspection Reports (VIR) are repaired before the vehicle is re-dispatched. Require drivers to prepare Vehicle Inspection Reports on a daily basis. Keep them on file for 90 days.

Remarks:

Mrs. Janae Eng, 50% owner of Columbia Basin Movers And Storage LLC (Columbia Basin Movers) was contacted at the carrier's terminal located at 1520 S. Pioneer Way Suite B, Moses Lake WA on March 24 - 25, 2010, for the purpose of conducting a safety compliance review and vehicle inspection.

This carrier operates one 32,000 GVWR straight truck requiring a driver with a valid commercial drivers license (CDL) and employs one owner-operator CDL driver Don Eng, as a for-hire intrastate household goods mover.

The carrier was requested to produce the following information at least 48 hours before this compliance review was scheduled:

- 1. Financial responsibility
2. Crash information
3. Driver qualification files
4. Hours of service records
5. Inspection, repair and maintenance records, including annual (periodic) inspections
6. Controlled substance and alcohol testing records
7. Commercial driver's license information

The company maintains supporting documents consisting of trip records, time cards and other data. The eFOTM international sampling requirement calls for 30 RODS to be reviewed for the one driver, however this could not be accomplished since the company had only conducted 16 business trips in the last 12 months.





Part C

Mrs. Eng is responsible for the supporting documents kept at the carrier's principal place of business. The management filing system for this company was found to be well organized, indicative of a company dedicated to safety and compliance with UTC requirements and regulations. Mr. Eng's drivers status was check using CDLIS and found that he has a current and valid Class-B CDL license.

The consortium used for the annual CDL driver drug and alcohol testing is Wenatchee Valley OCC Health/Intox. PO Box 2087 Wenatchee WA 98807. 509-663-8711. Testing documents for Mr. Eng are done on appropriate DOT forms, using the approved sampling of 50% for drugs and 10% for alcohol. In 2009 Mr. Eng was tested four times for drugs and four times for alcohol. Mrs. Eng felt this was a larger number than should be. I explained that a consortium use a random sampling number from the total number of drivers in their pool. Drivers names are normally selected quarterly by a system similar to pulling a name from a hat. Mr. Eng's name was just coincidental be drawn so many times this last year. But, it also could be that his name might not be drawn again for a few years. It was suggested that she should speak with her consortium if she has questions about the testing procedures.

Records of duty status (RODS) were found to be in order and compared with various supporting documents by checking time, date and location.

The carriers vehicle was inspected, found to be free of any violations and issued a CVSA decal number 12159837. The results are listed on the attached Aspen generated Uniform Driver/Vehicle Examination form number WAU00100249.

This carrier is insured by National Indemnity Insurance Company for \$750.000 under policy 70 TRS-012011.

The carrier said they have driven 2,389 miles during the last 12 months for intrastate trips and guessed they would drive another 2,000 miles during the next nine months for a total of over 4,389 intrastate miles during the current fiscal year.

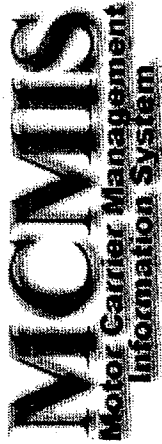
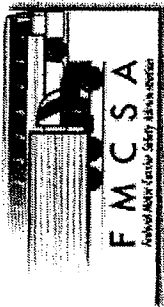
This company is currently in provisional status although actually having been in business and as a UTC regulated HHG carrier since 2006. Mrs. Eng explained that she was late in sending her premium check to her insurance company in November 2009 and as result the insurance agent notified UTC that the company was without minimum coverage. UTC cancelled the company's authority. Columbia Basin Movers re-applied for authority on 11-19-2009.

This carrier was found with minor violations as indicated in Part B of this report. The errors were corrected immediately. The compliance review was started on 3-24-2010 and finished on 3-25-2010. The proposed safety rating for this company is satisfactory. Mrs. Eng was present during the entire review process.

It is recommended the company be removed from provisional status and permanent authority be issued for an intrastate HHG for-hire carrier.
