- On July 26, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment TV-120268 against Eric Stewart d/b/a Ironman Moving Services (Ironman or Company) in the amount of \$2,300, alleging 23 violations of RCW 81.04 and WAC 480-15, which govern how household goods moving companies may operate, and Tariff 15-C, which identified the rates and charges a household goods moving company may charge its customers, the items a company must include on its estimates, and how a company must complete its bills of lading.
- On August 22, 2012, Ironman filed with the Commission a request for hearing stating that it "would like to have a chance to explain how it has come into compliance in a number of areas."
- On August 27, 2012, Commission Staff filed a Response stating that even though the request for hearing was not timely filed, it does support the Company's request for a hearing to facilitate settlement discussions that may address mitigation of the penalty.
- Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the penalty should be mitigated and what actions are necessary for Ironman to maintain future compliance, pursuant to statutory provisions of RCW 81.04.

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THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 10:30 a.m., on October 11, 2012, in Room 108, First Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.

- The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.
- Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.
- Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents no later than 5:00 p.m. on **October 4, 2012**, and bring an original and three (3) copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and 145.
