On August 31, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) awarded the Puget Sound & Pacific Railroad (PSAP) a GCPF grant in the amount of \$20,000 to modify and improve active warning devices at the Old Olympic Highway crossing in Shelton. The USDOT is #096560X. The estimated project cost was \$24,672.93 with PSAP paying for all costs exceeding that amount.

On June 6, 2013, PSAP submitted a request for reimbursement for work pursuant to Commission order. Because the commission does not currently have its own signal inspector, Jerome Polk, a certified FRA signal inspector, conducted a site visit on June 19, 2013, and verified that the project was completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
