1. THIS JOINT PETITION is filed by and on behalf of Mashell Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Rainier Connect ("Rainier Connect") and CenturyTel of Washington, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink ("CenturyLink") to modify the boundaries of Rainier Connect's Eatonville Exchange and CenturyLink's Ashford Exchange.

BASIS FOR PETITION

2. The Federal Communications Commission has promulgated a requirement for carriers to submit electronic maps of carrier study areas. As a part of that process, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") undertook to develop and submit the electronic

1	maps on behalf of many of the carriers. Under the FCC's published timeline, this means that the
2	study area maps were due to the FCC by June 28, 2013. ²
3	
4	3. The Commission developed study-area maps and submitted the maps to the affected
5	companies for review. In reviewing the information developed by the Commission, Rainier
6	Connect realized that it was serving customers that were physically in CenturyLink's Ashford
7	Exchange.
8	
9	4. Based on Rainier Connect's records, it appeared that that service to these customers
10	(fourteen in total) has existed from at least the mid 1990s. While records do not exist as to why
11	the service was undertaken, it is safe to assume that because of the terrain and location of these
12	customers, CenturyLink was unable to extend service on a cost effective basis at the time and it
13	was more cost effective for Rainier Connect to extend service.
14	
15	5. For the revised exchange map for Rainier Connect's Eatonville Exchange, please see the
16	final map filed in Docket UT-131292. For the revised map of the Ashford Exchange served by
17	CenturyLink, please see the final map filed in Docket UT-131322

19	ACTION REQUESTED
20	6. Pursuant to RCW 80.36.230, the Commission has the authority to establish each carriers
21	exchange boundaries.

6	for the Ashford Exchange or for the request for expedited treatment.
