Dear Mr. King:
On June 26, 2017, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a $\$ 1,000$ Penalty Assessment in Docket UT-170441 against ComSpan Communications, Inc. for ten violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC 480-120-382), which requires telecommunication companies to furnish annual reports and the regulatory fee to the commission no later than May 1 each year. ComSpan Communications, Inc. had the option to have $\$ 750$ of the $\$ 1,000$ penalty suspended on the conditions that: (1) ComSpan Communications, Inc. files a complete annual report; and (2) pays any outstanding regulatory fee; and (3) pays the $\$ 250$ portion of the penalty that is not suspended within 15 days of the receipt of the Penalty Assessment Notice.

After reviewing commission records, staff confirmed on August 8, 2017, that all three conditions of the penalty suspension was met as ComSpan Communications, Inc. filed a complete annual report, paid the outstanding regulatory fee and paid the $\$ 250$ portion of the unsuspended penalty. As all three conditions have been met, it is staff's recommendation that the $\$ 750$ suspended portion of the penalty be waived and the docket closed.
