The following items need to be completed and/or corrected for prompt processing of your application for operating authority. Please complete and return to our office by July 28, 2017. You may not operate until these issues are resolved and you have received your approved permit.

- You stated your brother will be the only one working with you, so you do not require an Employment Security registration number. As he is not an owner of the business, if you have not already, please clarify with the employment security department that you do not need to be registered with them. If you can provide something in writing from them, that would be very helpful. They can be reached at 360-902-9396 or visit <https://www.esd.wa.gov/> for information.

- Request a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E) and Cargo Insurance (Form H) from your insurance company. The insurance must show your name EXACTLY as it is shown above, and, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) must be shown as the certificate holder. Please ask your insurance company to email the insurance to transportation@utc.wa.gov.
