**NOTICE RESCHEDULING CLASSIFICATION PROCEEDING
(Now set for Monday, February 25, 2019, at 9 a.m.)**

Re: *In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties against Galaxy Moving Company LLC*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 8, 2019, the Commission issued an order instituting a special proceeding on its own motion to determine whether Galaxy Moving Company LLC (Galaxy Moving or Company) has engaged, and is engaging, in business as a household goods carrier within the state of Washington without the authority required by RCW 81.80 (classification proceeding).

The Commission ordered Hong “Richard” Brooks or a representative of Galaxy Moving appear before the Commission in this classification proceeding on February 12, 2019, at the Commission’s headquarters in Olympia, Washington, to give testimony and evidence under oath as to its operations.

The National Weather Service has issued a winter storm watch for this weekend and is predicting additional snowfall on February 12, 2019. Because Parties to the proceeding may be traveling a long distance to appear, and the Commission wants to ensure that the parties receive advance notice of any postponement of the proceeding due to unsafe driving conditions or office closures, the Commission finds good cause to reschedule the classification proceeding to February 25, 2019, at 9 a.m. The subpoena continues to be in effect until the hearing is completed.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the classification proceeding in docket TV-180519 is rescheduled for February 25, 2019, at 9 a.m.
