Dear Iron Mountain Information Management Services, Inc.:

On October 30, 2018, Iron Mountain Information Management Services, Inc. filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to provide residential household goods transportation services in the state of Washington. On November 21, 2018, the Commission approved the application in part and granted Iron Mountain Information Management Services, Inc. temporary authority to provide those services.

The Commission has determined that Iron Mountain Information Management Services, Inc. qualifies for permanent household goods carrier authority and approves the application in full. Permit HG068526 issued in the name of Iron Mountain Information Management Services, Inc. is enclosed, and the company may now operate on a permanent basis.

Iron Mountain Information Management Services, Inc. must continue to comply with state laws, Commission rules, and the provisions of Tariff 15-C. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
