RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against B5X Industries, LLC, in the Amount of \$1,000, Docket D-181001

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On February 5, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against B5X Industries, LLC, (B5X Industries or Company) in the Amount of \$1,000 for one violation of RCW 19.122.030(2). In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission offered the Company the option to suspend, and ultimately waive, the penalty subject to the condition that the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months of the date of the Penalty Assessment.

On February 14, 2019, the Company notified the Commission that it accepted the condition, and on February 6, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that B5X Industries had met the condition. In its letter, Staff recommended the \$1,000 suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission agrees that B5X Industries has complied with the conditions of the penalty suspension. The \$1,000 suspended penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
