Dear Mr. Johnson:

Our Company has been notified by the City of Port Angeles that the tipping fee in Clallam County will decrease from \$148.17 to \$144.99 per ton, a 2.15% decrease, per Ordinance No. 3634, page 1, Section 1, 13.57.020 Rates, attached. This will decrease revenue and expense for the residential customers by approximately \$18,000 (.94%); commercial customers by \$11,000 (1.27%); and drop box service by \$14,000 (2.15% of pass through expense) for a 12-month period. There are approximately 9,300 residential, 800 commercial and 40 drop box customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase for Olympic Disposal was approved by the Commission, June 1, 2011.

As instructed by the UTC staff during the audit of TG-132227 and TG-132228 these audited calculations have been updated with the increase in tipping fees, no changes to tonnage or customer count have been made.

Attached are revised pages as well as supporting documentation to justify this increase. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they will become effective January 1, 2020. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2) (iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.
