TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 14, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01; Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; and Notice of Virtual Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Order 01), instituting proceedings against Burton Water Company, Inc. (Burton or Company). Order 01, among other things, set time for hearing on November 12, 2020.

On October 19, 2020, counsel for Burton informed the Commission that the Company is unavailable on November 12, 2020, and requested to reschedule the brief adjudicative proceeding. Staff does not oppose the request.

The Commission finds good cause to reschedule the brief adjudicative proceeding to November 18, 2020, at 1:30 p.m. to allow the Company to attend the hearing and testify.

Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, November 11, 2020, and bring an original and (3) copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140.
