BACKGROUND

- 1 On June 8, 2020, Super Friends Moving L.L.C. (Super Friends or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for a household goods moving permit (Application) in the above-captioned docket. The Company filed an updated Application on July 27, 2020.
- 2 On August 4, 2020, the Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Deny Application for Permanent Authority and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (Notice) in this matter based on its review and investigation of the application. The Commission alleges that Super Friends continues to operate as a household goods carrier without a permit in violation of applicable laws, Commission rules, and prior Commission orders. The Notice provided Super Friends the opportunity to request a hearing to contest the factual allegations set out in the Notice by August 19, 2020.
- 3 On August 4, 2020, Super Friends filed with the Commission a request for hearing.
- 4 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the Company's Application for permanent authority should be denied based on the factual allegations set out in the Notice.
- 5 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a virtual brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 9:30 a.m. on September 1, 2020. To attend the proceeding by telephone, please call (360) 407-3810 and enter the**

6 The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.

7 Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must electronically file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, August 25, 2020**. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140.

8 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.**
