 Note 2: Rates named in this item apply for all hauls not exceeding 10 miles from the point of pickup to the disposal site. Excess miles will be charged for at \$2.50 (A) per mile or fraction of a mile. Mileage charge is in addition to all regular charges.
 Note 3: Permanent Service is defined as no less than scheduled, once a month pickup, unless local government ordinances require more frequent service or unless putrescibles are involved.

- Accessorial charges assessed (lids, unlocking, unlatching, etc.)
 (a) When, upon customer request, a drop box with a lid is provided, the charge for the lid shall be \$37.40 (A) monthly or \$1.24 (A) per day.
 (b) When a collector is required to disconnect/reconnect a customer owned compactor from a drop box or container prior to taking it out to be dumped and then reconnecting the compactor when the drop box or container is returned to the customers site, the following charge will apply: \$9.98 (A) per load.
 (c) When a collector is required to open, unlock or close a gate in order to pick up solid waste, the following charge will apply per pickup: \$1.67 (A).
 (d) When a collector is required to tarp a drop box, the following charge will apply: \$10.33 (A) per load.
