Dear Amanda Maxwell:

In docket UW-220859, Washington Water Service Company requests the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission waive Washington Administrative Code 480-110-425 which requires 30-day notice to customers and potential customers of changes in the terms and conditions of existing services and/or ownership.

In a previous submission, Washington Water Service Company provided the results of the vote by the homeowners of the Driftwood Valley Association’s meeting held September 25, 2021. At the Association’s meeting, Washington Water Service Company provided information to the homeowners and proposed to purchase the Driftwood Valley Water System. The Association approval to purchase the water system came from the homeowners. As such, the customers are aware of Washington Water Service Company acquiring and operating the water system. Washington Water Service Company provided the outcome of the vote in its December 8, 2022, submission.

After discussions with Commission staff, Washington Water Service Company also sent out notices to the customers of the Driftwood Valley Association on December 9, 2022, stating how customers can contact the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission at its open meeting on December 22, 2022.
