**RE: DO NOT REDOCKET—Docket UE-220940
Replacement Sheet—Advice 22-06—Rule 11A—General Rules and Regulations**

On December 20, 2023, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company submitted an advice filing to revise Rule 11A with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) Rules and Regulations.

The purpose of this filing is to add language to Rule 11A to implement moratoriums on disconnection for non-payment during times of extreme weather and poor air quality. PacifiCorp has been implementing disconnection moratoriums in Washington in compliance with Commission rules and also of its own accord during extreme weather events. After a collaborative discussion with Commission staff, PacifiCorp is proposing adjustments to the cold weather conditions as described in the enclosed replacement tariff sheet.
