**NOTICE OF REDOCKETING OF
REVISED TARIFF FILING**

Re: *Cost Management Services, Inc. v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation,*
Docket UG-061256

TO THE PARTIES:

On February 12, 2006, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or Company) filed revised tariffs sheets for its tariff WN U-3. Cascade states that the filing is in compliance with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) Order 03 entered in this proceeding. The tariff sheets reflect an issue date of February 12, 2007, and an effective date of March 15, 2007.

The Company's tariff filing is not properly characterized as a compliance filing under WAC 480-07-880. Compliance filings are those the Commission authorizes or directs a party to file to implement the terms of a final order. Order 03 directed the Company to file tariff schedules to provide gas supply services to non-core customers to replace cancelled tariff schedules. Order 03, ¶¶ 66, 93, 140. Order 03 is not a final order, however, and does not identify specific terms or rates that the Company's tariff filing would implement. The order simply directs the Company to file new or replacement gas supply tariffs. Thus, the Company's tariff filing is more appropriately docketed as a new tariff or tariff revision for consideration at a Commission Open Meeting.

Given the March 15, 2007, effective date stated in the filing, the Commission will redocket the filing in Docket UG-070332 as a new tariff filing and will consider the filing at its March 14, 2007 Open Meeting. Should the Commission suspend the tariff

revisions at the Open Meeting for further consideration, the tariff revisions may be consolidated with the remaining issues in this proceeding.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the revised tariffs filed on February 12, 2007, in Docket UG-061256 as a compliance filing will be redocketed as a new tariff filing in Docket UG-070332. **The tariff revisions will be placed on the agenda for the Commission's March 14, 2007 Open Meeting.**
