4 A. My name is Michael Mullally. My business address is 10885 N.E. 4th Street, P.O.
5 Box 97034, Bellevue WA 98009-9734.

6 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

7 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (“PSE”) as Senior Energy Resource
8 Planning Acquisition Analyst.

9 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

10 A. I graduated from Santa Clara University in 1998 with a Bachelor of Science in
11 Commerce. I graduated from Duke University, The Fuqua School of Business in
12 2007 with a Master of Business Administration.

13 From 2002 to 2005, I worked as a Treasury Manager, Market Risk Analytics &
14 Forecasting Group at Washington Mutual, Inc. in Seattle, Washington. In that
15 position, I assisted with valuation of the bank’s mortgage servicing asset to assist
16 with risk mitigation and advised management on asset purchase opportunities.

17 In 2006, I served as Interim Director of Finance at Sustainable Systems, LLC, in
18 Missoula, Montana, in which position I supported equity fund raising efforts and
19 coauthored a USDA Renewable Energy Systems and Energy Efficiency
20 Improvements Grant.

1 In 2007, I served as a consultant to Pacific West Energy, LLC, in Santa Barbara,
2 California, in which position I developed financial models and business plan
3 materials for an ethanol project.

4 In 2007, I also served as Team Leader at the Duke University Independent Study -
5 Solar program in Durham, North Carolina. In that position, I produced project
6 pro forma models, evaluated different energy markets where localized conditions
7 favored commercial project development, identified development opportunities,
8 and recruited strategic partners to assist with commercial agreements,
9 development, and financing.

10 In 2007 through 2008, I was Manager, Business Development and Strategy for
11 US Biodiesel Group, LLC in Kailua-Kona, Hawaii, in which position I evaluated
12 financial feasibility of project opportunities; directed development efforts to
13 deploy under-utilized assets; and analyzed manufacturing plant logistics to
14 accommodate global input sourcing and guide layout decisions.

15 In August 2008, I assumed my current position as Senior Energy Resource
16 Acquisition Analyst at PSE. In my current position, I have participated in various
17 corporate initiatives, including managing efforts to deploy solar technology in
18 Washington, evaluating and negotiating substantial equipment contracts, and
19 leading financial evaluation and budgeting process for major projects.
