ORDER OF DEFAULT

I. BASIS

This matter came before the Court on plaintiffs', State of Washington and the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's, motion for an order of default against defendant Sani Maurou d/b/a SEATAC AIRPORT 24 a/k/a SEATACAIRPORT24.COM

1 a/k/a EXPRESS ONE a/k/a SHUTTLEEXPRESS24.COM a/k/a SANI & PARTNERS. The
2 motion was based on the grounds that the defendant had not appeared, answered, or otherwise
3 defended in this action.

4 **II. FINDINGS**

5 The Court considered plaintiffs' default motion on this date. Notice of the motion was
6 given to defendant Sani Maurou d/b/a SEATAC AIRPORT 24 a/k/a
7 SEATACAIRPORT24.COM a/k/a EXPRESS ONE a/k/a SHUTTLEEXPRESS24.COM
8 a/k/a SANI & PARTNERS. *ver*

11 The Court considered the pleadings filed in this action, the declaration of plaintiffs'
12 counsel, Andrew J. O'Connell, and the following evidence: Declaration of Service of
13 Summons and Petition for Civil Enforcement on defendant by process server, attached as
14 Exhibit A to the declaration of Andrew J. O'Connell. *"Motion to Dismiss" filed by*
15 *defendant in response*
16 *with attached letter dated December 6, 2016*

Based on the pleadings and evidence presented, the Court finds:

- 17 1. Plaintiffs properly served defendant with plaintiffs' Summons and Petition for
18 Civil Enforcement in this action.
- 19 2. Defendant has failed to ~~appear~~, answer, or otherwise defend in this action.
- 20 3. No notice of appearance was filed by defendant with the Court, or was served
21 on plaintiffs or their counsel.
- 22 4. The time for defendant to answer the plaintiffs' Petition for Civil Enforcement
23 is within 20 days after the date of service. More than 20 days have passed since
24 the defendant was served with the Summons and Petition for Civil Enforcement.

5. Venue is proper in this action.


III. ORDER
