Seattle Public Utilities is pleased to support the WUTC's proposed rule amending WAC 480-120-251, Directory Service, so that local exchange companies (LEC) may only deliver residential listings directories to customers who request them.

This "opt-in" policy will allow those who want printed local listing directories to obtain them, while avoiding annual delivery of hundreds of thousands of unwanted directories statewide. There will be an enormous reduction in the amount of paper now being used in the printing of local listing directories, with cost savings accruing to solid waste agencies such as SPU that now recycle – and sometimes, unfortunately, landfill some of those phone books.

As noted in our letter of May 18, Seattle operates a web-based phone book opt-out service for city residents and businesses. Since that service began, more than 20 percent of all Seattle residents (about 75,000 addresses) have opened accounts and opted out of phone book deliveries to their homes. Altogether, Seattleites have stopped almost 435,000 individual directory deliveries, saving about 400 tons of paper annually.

Importantly, the vast majority of people who have used this service have opted out of ALL the phone book titles that could be delivered to their homes or businesses. This includes local listings – the white pages. Our data show that almost 70,000 users of the service have declined the white pages as well as yellow pages.

We can't imagine better evidence that large numbers of people no longer want printed local listing directories and that, therefore, the WUTC decision to require white pages delivery only when residents or businesses request them is timely and responds to community wishes.
