## NOTICE OF HEARING AND FILING REQUIREMENTS

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission vs. DTG Enterprises, Inc., Docket TG-240761

#### TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 18, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a complaint against DTG Enterprises, Inc., (DTG or Company) for violations of state law and administrative rule and noticed a prehearing conference for February 6, 2025.

The Commission convened a virtual prehearing conference on February 6, 2025, before Administrative Law Judge Harry Fukano.

On March 18, 2025, the Commission issued Order 02, which among other things, contained a procedural schedule for this matter. Order 02 further requested that the parties confer amongst themselves and identify a proposed hearing length for this proceeding.

On March 28, 2025, counsel for the Company emailed the presiding ALJ and stated that the Company, Staff and the intervenors requested a three-day hearing from November 17, 2025, to November 19, 2025. Subsequently on March 31, 2025, Public Counsel emailed the presiding ALJ to confirm that it also agreed to a three-day hearing from November 17, 2025, to November 19, 2025.

The Commission finds good cause to modify the existing procedural schedule to reflect hearing dates of November 17, 18, and 19, 2025, and issue a revised procedural schedule attached hereto as Appendix A.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the Commission modifies the procedural schedule in this matter to schedule a hybrid evidentiary hearing for November 17, 2025, to November 19, 2025, as shown in Appendix A, attached hereto.

THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE That in addition to the filing requirements identified in Order 02, when filing testimony, exhibits, or post-hearing briefs,

the filing party must submit five paper copies to the Commission within three business days of its electronic filing. This requirement does not apply to exhibits comprised of tables or worksheets more than five pages long. The Commission is otherwise suspending any requirements for paper copies. WAC 480-07-460.
