I. INTRODUCTION

1 Pursuant to WAC § 480-07-375(1)(d), Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities
("ICNU") files the following motion ("Motion"), requesting that the Washington Utilities and
Transportation Commission (the "Commission") strike specified portions from the as-filed
testimony and exhibits of Robert R. Stephens, filed on behalf of ICNU in Docket UE-170485.
Mr. Stephens' revised testimony, with specific sections to be removed struck through,
accompanies this motion.

2 ICNU has conferred with representatives of Avista Corporation, Commission
Staff, and Public Counsel, and none oppose ICNU's motion.

II. MOTION TO STRIKE

3 ICNU has decided to withdraw certain section of Mr. Stephens' testimony prior to
the Commission's hearing in this matter, scheduled for January 16-18. Specifically, ICNU seeks
to remove the sections of Mr. Stephens' testimony that address his proposed Demand Response
Tariff, including in Exhibit RRS-10, filed with the Commission on November 1, 2017 and

December 1, 2017, respectively. Pursuant to WAC § 480-07-375(1)(d), the Commission may modify a proceeding's evidentiary record upon request. Therefore, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission strike the specified portions of Mr. Stephens' testimony.
