- 9 The tariff revisions filed by Verizon Northwest, Inc., on December 8, 2000, in accordance with the Twenty-Ninth Supplemental Order in this proceeding, shall become effective as filed, and that the rates, charges and conditions set forth in the tariff revisions are specified as the rates, charges, and conditions to be applicable to service on and after December 15, 2000.
- 10 THE COMMISSION ORDERS FURTHER That it retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to effectuate the provisions of this and prior orders in these proceedings.
