BACKGROUND

- 1 On December 15, 2000, the Commission entered its Thirty-First Supplemental Order, Order on Reconsideration; Modifying Prior Order; Directing Refiling in this proceedings. The Order directed Qwest to refile deaveraged wire center rates consistent with the result of that Order.

- 2 Qwest Corporation (the successor to U S WEST Communications, Inc.) on December 22, 2000, filed Advice No. 3190T containing replacement pages for its Tariffs No. WN U-42. This included the following:

3 Commission Staff has reviewed the Company's compliance tariff filing and states

with the Thirty-First Supplemental Order in this proceeding, shall become effective
pursuant to the terms of that Order, and that the rates, charges, and conditions are
applicable to service on and after 12:01 a.m. on the day following entry of this Order.

7 THE COMMISSION ORDERS FURTHER That it retains jurisdiction over the
subject matter and the Parties to effectuate the provisions of this and prior order in
these proceedings.
