RE: DO NOT REDOCKET—Docket UE-190666—Request to Extend Effective Date

On May 28, 2020, PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp) submitted a standard power purchase agreement (Standard PPA) as an attachment to Schedule QF, Avoided Cost Purchases and Procedures for Qualifying Facilities, in compliance with WAC 480-106 et. seq.

After numerous rounds of negotiations, PacifiCorp has reached an agreement with the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC) and the Renewable Energy Coalition (REC) regarding the Standard PPA for new QFs.

At staff's recommendation, in addition to the Standard PPA for new QFs, PacifiCorp is developing a Standard PPA for existing facilities/renewals. While the Standard PPA for existing facilities will be based on the agreed upon form of contract for new QFs, PacifiCorp needs additional time to address any concerns that may be raised by NIPPC and REC. PacifiCorp proposes to file the two Standard PPAs, for new and existing facilities, together and, accordingly, requests to extend the effective date to March 12, 2021.
