AT&T'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE A SURREPLY REGARDING BENCH REQUEST NO. 12

Respondent AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc. ("AT&T"), by and through its attorneys, respectfully submits this Motion for Leave to File a Surreply Regarding Bench Request No. 12. In support of this Motion, AT&T states the following:

1. On November 30, 2010, the Commission issued Bench Request No. 12 to AT&T.

AT&T filed its Response to Bench Request No. 12 on December 8, 2010. Complainants and T-Netix filed Replies regarding Bench Request No. 12 on December 15, 2010.

2. Complainants' and T-Netix's Replies both raise new factual material and argument that AT&T has had no opportunity to address. For example, Complainants for the first time refer, entirely out of context, to comments made in other proceedings. Similarly, T-Netix makes entirely new factual assertions about its initiation of service. Both Complainants' and T-Netix's Replies are misleading with respect to the effect of Amendment No. 2 to the DOC contract. AT&T has not had the opportunity to address these arguments by Complainants or T-Netix regarding Amendment No. 2, and the Commission will benefit from clarification as to the misleading aspects of Complainants' and T-Netix's arguments.

3. Accordingly, AT&T respectfully requests leave to file a Surreply addressing Bench Request No. 12 and Complainants' and T-Netix's Replies thereto, focusing on the misleading aspects of the Replies. AT&T's response is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

WHEREFORE, AT&T respectfully requests leave to file the Surreply Regarding Bench Request No. 12 and T-Netix's Response Thereto, attached as Exhibit A to this Motion for Leave.
