CenturyLink objects to this Request because it is vague, ambiguous, overly broad, unduly burdensome and excessively time consuming as written, seeks information that is not relevant and is not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence in this proceeding. CenturyLink further objects to the request to the extent that it calls for information that is third-party proprietary information which is subject to a confidentiality agreement.

CenturyLink Response:

Subject to and without waiving its objections, CenturyLink provides the following response: As a result of the integration of Embarq and CenturyTel applications, the EZLocal application used by CLECs doing business with CenturyTel was retired, as it had no system to system functionality or interfaces to back office applications.
