Dear Ms. Maxwell:

MASHELL TELECOM, INC. DBA RAINIER CONNECT ("MASHELL"), a privately-held rate of return carrier receiving high cost support, has electronically submitted FCC Form 481 to the Commission with redacted Line 3005 financial data. MASHELL respectfully provides the Commission with its confidential financial data so that all its reporting obligations are satisfied.

MASHELL, by its authorized representative, respectfully submits confidential information in compliance with 47 C.F.R. §§ 54.313 and 54.422, under seal, as specified with the Protective Ordered adopted on November 16, 2012 reference DA 12-1857 ("Protective Order") and also in conjunction with WAC 480-07-160.

MASHELL requests confidential treatment of certain information submitted with its annual reporting requirements as a privately-held rate of return carrier and high-cost recipient in Docket No. 10-90. The confidential information is required by 47 C.F.R. § 54.313(f)(2) and includes detailed financial information that is competitively sensitive. Disclosure of this confidential information would have a substantial negative impact on MASHELL. Such information would not normally be made available to the public for inspection because of the financial information and should be afforded confidential treatment under WAC 480-07-160.

As specified in the WAC 480-07-140, copies of the redacted confidential information are being filed simultaneously with the non-redacted confidential information. The redacted information for this filing and each page of the file where confidential information has been omitted is marked "REDACTED - FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION" and the confidential submission is marked





CERTIFICATION LOAN DEFAULT NOTES TO THE OPERATING REPORT FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS BORROWERS

During 2021, Mashell Telecom, Inc. experienced increased operating costs and a decrease in customer base related to Covid 19. Along with increased operating costs, we continue to experience 6-12 month supply chain shortages which have delayed construction. We also saw an uptick in subscriber churn both business and residential due to the pandemic.We continue to monitor and develop alternative plans to overcome the supply chain shortage. Our Company focus has been on community involvement and continuing to provide premier customer service.Despite all of this, we were able to complete core network upgrades, which will allow us to provide gigabit service across our entire serving area. This network upgrade was a year long process, during which time we discontinued all marketing efforts until the network was stable enough to provide the superior service we stand behind. We increased customer CATV rates effective January 1, 2022 to bring this product line closer to net neutral and implemented a policy of annual price increases to cover rising programming costs. We expect this product line to be be net neutral by 2023. We started marketing in 2022, and expect to see an increase in subscribers beginning the second half of this year.
