

Definition: In plumbing, a trap with a vertical inlet and a horizontal outlet. A drain trap is required between the outlet from a lavatory, sink or tub and the main waste line. The p trap provides a water seal above the waste or soil pipe. This seal keeps sewer gases and odors from entering the room. The p trap gets its name from its shape, which resembles the letter "P." A p trap is used when fixtures are mounted against an interior wall and the drain pipe fitting is inside the wall.
