TO PARTIES OF RECORD:

On December 13, 2001, AT&T filed with the Commission a Petition for Administrative Review on General Terms & Conditions Initial Order and Petition to Reopen (Workshop IV). On December 21, 2001, both Covad and Qwest made filings with the Commission in this proceeding. Covad filed a Combined Motion for Leave to File Supplemental Comments Regarding Loop Issue 3(b) of the Twentieth Supplemental Order and Supplemental Comments on Loop Issue 3(b). Qwest filed a Submission of Supplemental KPMG Declaration and Declaration of Philip J. Jacobsen.

These filings all pertain to issues addressed in Workshop IV of this proceeding. The Commission is scheduled to hear argument on the Twentieth Supplemental Order; Initial Order on Workshop IV, on January 10, 2002. In order to fairly address all Workshop IV issues, any party wishing to comment on AT&T's, Covad's, or Qwest's filings must do so by the close of business, **Friday, January 4, 2002**.
