Pursuant to WAC 480-07-385, Puget Sound Energy ("PSE" or the "Company") is requesting a three-week continuance, until March 9, 2009, of the deadline for PSE to file its 2008 Service Quality Program Report and Service Provider Report. The due date of these two reports (and the other service quality related report) is on February 15, 2009, as prescribed in page 3, section E, Exhibit J of the Settlement Stipulation Re Service Quality Index ("SQI") in Docket Nos. UE-011570 and UG-011571.

On October 8, 2008, the Commission adopted certain amendments and additional service quality requirements and conditions in Docket Nos. UE-072300 and UG-072301. These requirements and conditions became effective in 2009 and PSE's first annual service quality performance report and service provider under the revised terms will be due on February 15, 2010. The Company, however, has been working on an attachment to its 2008 Service Quality Program Report to include the information that would be required in the 2009 annual reports for the preview of the Commission and other interested parties. The underlying goal of this attachment is to develop a better service quality program report and a better service provider report going forward by incorporating external feedback and suggestions prior to the 2010 actual filing.

The attachment is taking longer to complete than the Company had expected. After communicating with the Commission Staff and with their agreement, PSE respectfully requests this continuance. The Gas Emergency Response Plan Report, for the 2008 reporting period will still be filed on February 13, 2009.
