**NOTICE RESCINDING POLICY STATEMENT**

RE: In the Matter of the Proceeding to Develop a Policy Statement Addressing the Impacts of the Climate Commitment Act,  
Docket U-230161

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On August 15, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a policy statement in Docket U-230161 titled *The Policy Statement Addressing the Issues and Impacts of the Climate Commitment Act* (Policy Statement). The Policy Statement included guidance regarding six topics: 1) Defining and Identifying Low-Income Customers, 2) Renewable Natural Gas (RNG) as a Decarbonization Pathway, 3) Utility Planning (Short and Long Term), 4) Cost Recovery, 5) Forecast Approval Timeline, and 6) Risk Sharing Mechanisms.
