On this basis, I hereby certify to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") for use by the Commission in providing the certification to the Federal Communications Commission and Universal Service Administrative Company required by 47 C.F.R. §54.314, as follows:
- (1) That the Company will use federal high-cost universal service fund support only for the provision, maintenance and upgrading of the facilities and services for which the support is intended;

Mashell Telecom, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits the following reports in accordance with WAC 480-123-070 and WAC 480-123-080.

<u>Report 1</u>: WAC 480-123-070(1)(a): Attached is a copy of the Company's NECA-1 Report for the calendar years 2004 and 2005, that, as of the date of the report, the Company is reporting as the basis for support from the federal high-cost fund.

Report 2: WAC 480-123-070(1)(b): The Company reports that the investments and expenses reported under Report 1, above, benefited customers as follows:

Through the expenditure of these funds, the Company was able to continue to provide services at a level that the Company believes meets the intent set forth in 47 U.S.C. §254 of providing high quality telecommunications services to customers in the service area for which the Company is designated as an ETC.² The Company has made substantial investments over the past several years which allow it to provide quality telecommunications services to its customers in its designated ETC service area. Those expenditures and investments, including those reflected in Report 1, above; generally benefit all customers receiving the federal high-cost fund supported services from the Company within its designated service area. In addition, during 2005, the Company was engaged in a major investment project within its designated ETC service area as described below:

Year 2005 Major Projects

- 1) Clear Lake Rebuild
 - a. Project cost \$ 207,000
 - b. This project replaced aerial facilities. The area has numerous trees which affected service because of wind damage.
- 2) Rath Plat
 - a. Project cost \$ 128,000
 - b. The project placed new facilities in a subdivision to provide service
- 3) Tekno Billing Sys
 - a. Project cost \$ 62,000
 - b. System was purchased to monitor SS7 data for both originating and terminating traffic. It allows the company to analyze traffic to monitor both toll and EAS trunks and the carriers utilizing our facilities
- 4) Silver Lake Highlands
 - a. Project cost \$ 55,000

- b. Projects places an AFC digital loop carrier to provide service and establish a digital serving area
- 5) Weyer Dev McKenna N
 - a. Project cost \$ 45,000
 - b. Placement of facilities to serve new customers
- 6) Town of Eatonville
 - a. Project cost \$ 20,000
 - b. Project provides new services and improving the quality of the existing services
- 7) Smith Acres
 - a. Project cost \$ 14,000
 - b. Project will provide new service in a development

Report 3: WAC 480-123-070(4): The Company reports that inquiries with the FCC, WUTC, and Attorney General indicate those agencies have not received any complaints concerning the company's service during 2005.

<u>Report 4</u>: WAC 480-123-080(1)(b) and WAC 480-123-080(2): The Company reports as follows:

The new system will improve the quality of our bills sent to the customers, ability to sign up for service online without incurring manual intervention, and eliminate other manual tasks being performed by our customer service reps today. The system would also create efficiencies by eliminating many manual processes such as circuit inventories, hunt group provisioning, increasing timeliness of service order processing, etc.
- 3) There will be additional Capital expenditures during 2007. The projects will be defined during our normal budgeting process.

The company has not started its 2007 budgeting process, but the company should have an approved budget in the 4th quarter of 2006. The company anticipates that expense levels will be consistent with 2005 actual levels with some minor affects due to inflation or efficiencies. Should there be significant change, this report will be amended with the new data.
