STIPULATED WITHDRAWAL OF

1. On October 12, 2011, Public Counsel filed a Motion to Compel production by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (PSE), of certain documents responsive to Public Counsel Data Requests 16-18. The undersigned counsel for PSE and Public Counsel have subsequently conferred and agreed to a resolution of the dispute. PSE has advised that, in the event the motion were to be granted, there are no additional responsive documents beyond what has already been produced in response to data requests. Public Counsel and PSE accordingly stipulate to a withdrawal of the Motion to Compel with the understanding that withdrawal does not establish any precedent and



does not constitute a waiver by either party of any argument, objection or position either party may wish to take in the future with respect to the issues raised by the motion.


