Dear Mr. Danner:

Public Counsel initially indicated to Northwest Natural Gas it would oppose the company's request in this docket for a prudence finding regarding its joint venture with Encana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. (Encana). Public Counsel consequently did not object to the Joint Motion to Allow Withdrawal of Tariff Filing in September 2011. Public Counsel's concerns centered on the risks and uncertainties associated with the transaction, including the long term nature of the venture, uncertainties regarding future gas prices, the environmental risks, and the unproven track record for this type of transaction.

This letter is to confirm that Public Counsel has no objection to the Settlement Stipulation between Commission Staff and Northwest Natural Gas filed April 24, 2012, in this docket. Public Counsel's position is based on the understanding that, as provided in paragraph 24 of the Stipulation, this agreement is limited to this transaction, and if approved has no precedential effect with respect to any future transactions or proposals of Northwest Natural Gas or other regulated Washington company. Public Counsel reserves the right to respond to and take any position with regard to the issues raised by any such future proposals or transactions.
